Message from Pastor

I love a good story but sometimes I get stuck because a book or a movie is too long and I can't make it to the ending. Sitting in that uncertainty often leads to late nights or restless sleep, because the ending is so crucial. In many ways we may feel like we've been living in one long and uncertain chapter without knowing where our story and the world's story is going to end, and I have to admit that the uncertainty is a bit overwhelming. As we approach Easter I am always excited to get to the resurrection despite the deep time of contemplation during Lent, but there is one of the Gospels that doesn't have the ending I want.

This year we look at the Easter story according to Mark. After the drama of Holy Week with the last supper and crucifixion we come to that amazing morning with the empty tomb. The women show up to anoint the dead body, the stone is rolled away and an angel speaks to them. "He is not here, he has been raised, go and tell everyone." We are almost there, but then the story ends with the women running away in terror saying nothing to anyone because they were afraid. That's it. The end. There are other endings to Mark in your bible, but those were added much later. It's like the story hasn't ended.

I think that this is exactly what Easter is about. Yes, it's about the new life and hope that the resurrected Christ has for all of us, but it's about a story that hasn't ended yet. This is also an amazing gift because that means that you and I get to be a part of this new life and hope that has broken out in the world. We are part of a story of struggle, fear, and hopelessness that leads to life, grace, and hope, and that story continues to unfold each and every day.

As a community we will continue to step into God's Easter story that unfolds in all sorts of ways. In a place where the world, communities, families, and we ourselves are uncertain about how the story ends, we have a place here at Family of Christ where we can gather together and journey together. A place that proclaims hope, forgiveness, grace, love, and a risen savior that leads to the happiest of endings.

So join us this Easter and come for the hope of a story that includes you and the resurrected Christ.

7:00 PM

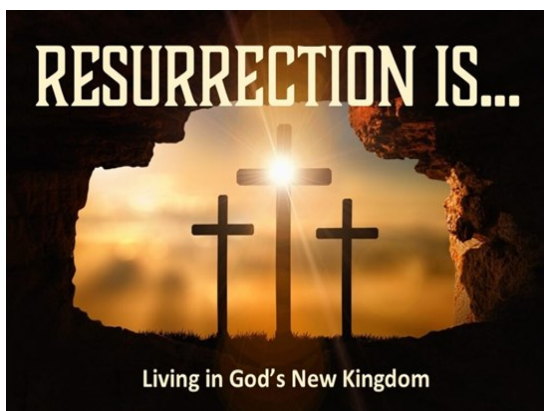
On Good Friday we gather to remember Jesus' suffering and death on the cross. Join us as we understand what God's gift of love was willing to embrace for us through music and art.

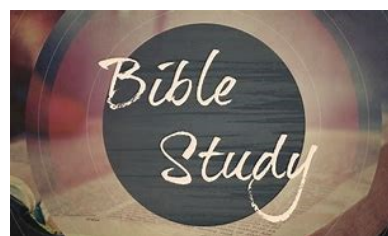

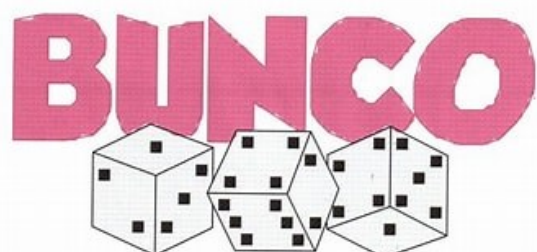

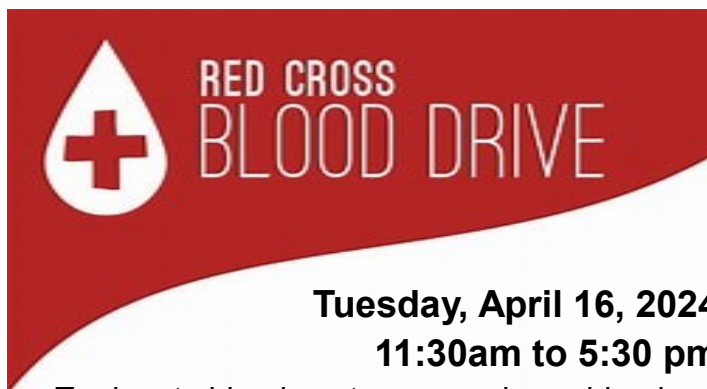
